1	14.1 Those undergraduate students failing (get 'F' grade) in any course or gets 'F' grade due to shortage of attendance shall have to repeat that or its equivalent recommended alternate course whenever offered.				

- However, "F" grade obtained earlier will also be recorded on the transcript. 14.2
- An undergraduate student obtaining a 'D' grade, can also be allowed to repeat the course when offered to 14.3 improve his/her grade for undergraduate students.
- 14.4 An undergraduate (BS) student can be allowed to repeat a maximum of six courses (18 credit hours) to improve their grades.
  - An undergraduate (MA/MSc level) student can be allowed to repeat a maximum of three courses (09 credit hours) to improve their grades.
- When an alternate course is taken for improvement, in such a case, both courses (old & alternate) and the 14.5 grades obtained will be recorded on the transcript, however, only the better grade shall be calculated in the CGPA.
- 14.6 Whenever a student fails or gets a 'D' grade, he/she can repeat the course when offered to improve his/her grade for undergraduate students.
- A graduate student (MS/MPhil) with a 'C' grade or below can repeat the course if s/he desires to improve the 14.7 grade. To graduate students (MS/MPhil) maximum two courses (08 credit hours) for repeating can be allowed.
- In case a student repeats the course which has already been taken, 14.8
  - the old grade will be replaced with the new grade, (for CGPA calculation). a.
  - but in case a student takes a new course in lieu of the course in which he/she failed, both the grades b. will reflect on his/her transcript, i.e. old course grade and new course grade.
- 14.9 In case of CGPA improvement, it would be recorded with (Imp) on the transcript. However, in case such a student does not improve his/her grade, the previously obtained grade will reflect in the transcript.
- 14.10 If a student absents himself in a test for any reason, no separate test will be arranged for him/her. (except as described in Rule 16.7)
